



Recommendation Strategic Actions Post-Disaster Heritage Recovery of West Sumatra

The Indonesia Heritage Trust concerns about the earthquake in West Sumatra on 30th September 2009 which damaged built, cultural and landscape heritage of Padang and surroundings. Soon afterwards, the Trust has conducted emergency actions as follows (1) fund raising, (2) rapid assessment of damaged heritage, (3) drawing and identification of built heritage which are prioritized for rehabilitation, (4) dissemination of information and coordination with various local, national and international stakeholders.

Following up the emergency actions that have been taken in cooperation with government institutions, universities and private sector, below steps will be taken:

- Coordination amongst all stakeholders to ensure that rehabilitation and reconstruction process runs as a whole and collective efforts;
- Preparation for rehabilitation and reconstruction process in terms on policies, capacity building of human resources and funding;
- Socialization and raising awareness about importance of heritage in rehabilitation and reconstruction process.

Recommendation of strategic actions:

1. The Indonesia Heritage Trust supports the Municipality of Padang in establishing the Rehabilitation and Reconstruction Agency (BPRR) with 7 early recovery priorities as follows :
 - a. Relocation of center of government offices
 - b. Education
 - c. Health
 - d. Infrastructure
 - e. Social, culture, economic development including heritage conservation
 - f. Mental spiritual
 - g. Formulation of documents for action planning :
 - i. Master plan of center of government offices
 - ii. Rehabilitation of city center
 - iii. Revitalization of old part of Padang
 - iv. Master plan of education area
2. Grand design of old and new parts of Padang is urgently required to prepare with some considerations as follow :
 - a. City planning that accommodates the impact of natural disaster;
 - b. Improvement of city infrastructures such as drainage, public transportation, pedestrian area.
 - c. Improvement of cleanliness of city by modernizing the waste process;
 - d. Considering the concept of green city, friendly access for all, appreciations for local heritage.
3. Suggesting all government bodies to include heritage conservation in rehabilitation reconstruction process.

In conducting rehabilitation reconstruction process, the Indonesian Heritage Trust suggests the following points:

1. Dialogues amongst stakeholders to formulate technical and non-technical guidance for rehabilitation reconstruction process;
2. The Indonesian Heritage Trust and its counterparts will assist in identification and documentation of heritage, formulating conservation guidance for heritage site and built heritage post-disaster, capacity building trainings and conservation actions on the field;
3. The Indonesian Heritage Trust supports socialization of rehabilitation reconstruction guidance for public.
4. The Indonesian Heritage Trust supports the Heritage Technical Service Point/Clinic for public who needs advices and this point functions also as center point for communication amongst stakeholders;
5. The Indonesian Heritage Trust has established the Heritage Emergency Response Team to respond quickly when natural disasters happen in the country.
